---

The following changes are included in version 1.2.16:

### New Features

- Added support for vSphere 8.0.

### Bug Fixes / Improvements

- Fixed tasks not being marked as failed following a mismatched System ID.
- Removed support for vSphere 6.0.

---

The following changes are included in version 1.2.14:

### New Features

- None.

### Bug Fixes / Improvements

- Fixed compatibility issue with vCenter 6.7U3l and Nexsan systems with firmware prior to Q/R011.1208.8 / S011.1305.2.  
Symptoms include:
  - “Failed to add Nexsan system” error when first adding a system to vCenter
  - “Unable to contact system” on overview page for a Nexsan system
  - “Operation timed out” or “Cannot complete the operation” failures for Nexsan tasks in the “Recent Tasks” list
- Fixed misaligned "Create Datastore" button on System "Volumes/Datastores" tab and "Configure > Storage Volumes" pages.

---

The following changes are included in version 1.2.12:

### New Features

- Added support for vSphere Client “Dark” theme (excluding modal dialogs).

### Bug Fixes / Improvements

- Fixed “Uncaught (in promise)” warning message in status bar when opening the “Add System” dialog.
- Fixed compatibility issue with vCenter 6.0.
- Performance and reliability improvements.

## Release Notes – version 1.2.6

---

The following changes are included in version 1.2.6:

### New Features

- Added units selector (GB/TB/GiB/TiB) to “Create Volume” and “Expand Volume” actions.
- Added “Beacon” button under system “General” configuration page.
- Added free space and capacity graphic to system “Storage Pools” configuration page.

### Bug Fixes / Improvements

- Allow deployment server SSL certificate changes during “Check for Updates” and “Install Updates” (with warning).

- Added support for managing hardware-based replication.\*
- Display creation date for volumes and storage pools.\*

- Explicitly report controller faults under system “All Issues” monitoring page.
- Display event log timestamps in the client’s timezone instead of system’s timezone.\*
- Various performance and reliability improvements.

## Release Notes – version 1.1.18

---

The following changes are included in version 1.1.18:

### New Features

- Enabled built-in updating via “Check for Updates” and “Install Update” actions on “Options” page.
- Added “Import Datastore” command to mount copied datastores (snapshots, clones, or replicas), and add any VMs or templates to the vSphere inventory.
- Display host multipathing policy on system/volume “Connected Hosts” pages and host “Nexsan Storage” page.
- Added average latency to port/volume performance graphs and tables.\*

### Bug Fixes / Improvements

- Fixed incorrectly-reported used capacity for volumes.
- Demoted replicas are now correctly removed from volume lists.
- Perform additional checks for existing partitions before creating a new datastore.
- Fixed minor layout issues on various UI pages.
